Title Woman's Shoe

Date about 1820-1825

Primary Maker Unknown

Medium Hand-stitched and pegged leather

Description Slit-vamp tie work shoe, probably for a woman. The throatline appears to have been square originally. The shoe is straight, with a low, pegged heel; the sole is made in two parts, with the waist overlapping the forepart.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (length x height x width): $9 \frac{3}{8} \times 2 \frac{1}{4} \times 3 \frac{7}{8}$ in.
