**Title** Construction Work, possibly Stony Creek, Branford, Connecticut

**Date** early 20th century

**Primary Maker** Unknown

**Medium** Photography; gelatin silver print on paper

**Description** A steam engine at the left is being used to run a block and tackle attached to tall cranes or derricks. Barrels are stacked around the bases of the cranes. Men are at work on what appears to be a roadway or railbed. Trees are in the background.
