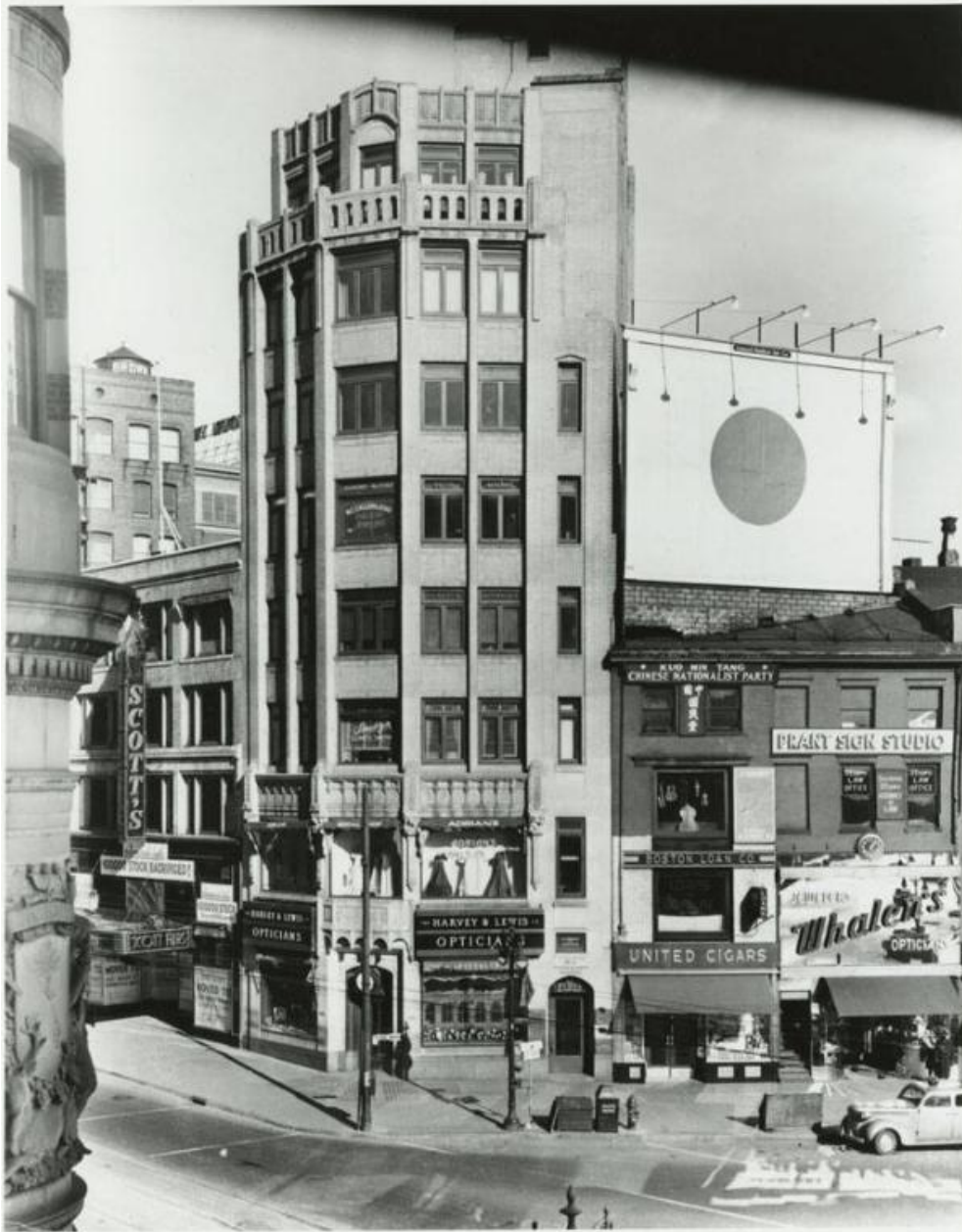

the offices of the Chinese Nationalist Party, the offices of the Hartford Courant,

the Princess Theater, the Hotel Oxford, the Far East Garden restaurant, M. Linn &

Sons clothing, and Clapp & Treat hardware store. Automobiles are parked on the

street. A truck has lettering that reads "Hartford Apron & Towel Supply Co.
