Description View of partially collapsed five-story building. Piles of rubble are on

the ground with many men standing on or near them. Men in uniform, probably

members of the Connecticut National Guard, are in the foreground. Two

wagons, each drawn by two horses, are in the muddy street, which is lined with

utility poles, wires and street lights. Buildings, probably including the First

Methodist Episcopal Church, are in the background. A sign reads: "Monuments."
