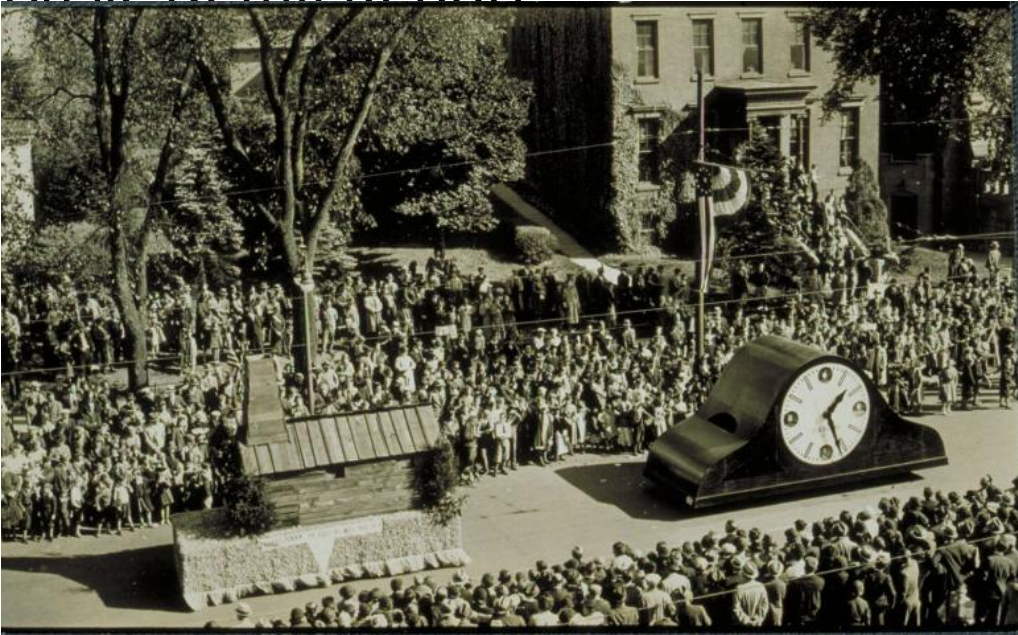

Title Tercentenary Parade: Rackliffe Oil Co. and Seth Thomas Clock

Co. floats, Main Street, Hartford, October 12, 1935

Description Parade floats in the shape of an oil well and a mantle clock. The float at the left has signs that read: "Drake's Folly" "First Oil Well in 1859, Sponsored by the Rackliffe Oil Co." Crowds of men, women and children line the sidewalks on both sides of the street. Banners hang from utility poles. The brick building is St. Peter's convent.
