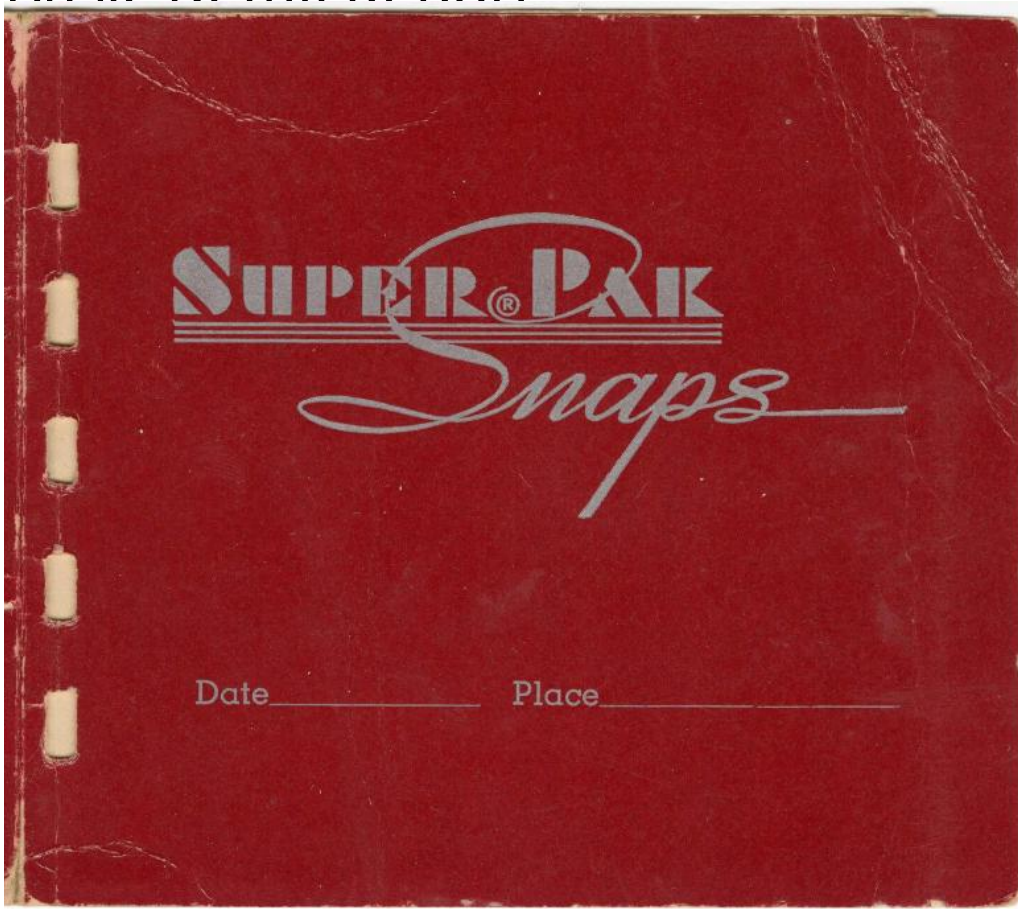

Description Small photograph album taken by Kenneth J. Winschel, probably at Camp Lejeune in North Carolina, c. 1952-1953, during the Korean War. The album has a red cover with silver printed text: "SUPER PAK / Snaps / Date / Place." The photographs are black and white. (.1) Ken Winschel standing in the doorway of his barrack. (.2) An unidentified man sitting on the barrack stoop. (.3) Ken Winschel standing next to the doorway of his barrack. (.4-.6) Ken Winschel

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and other unidentified men at a jeep. (.7-.8) Two men in a canoe. Ken Winschel is probably one of the men. (.9) An unidentified building next to a body of water. (.10) Ken Winschel in a canoe.
