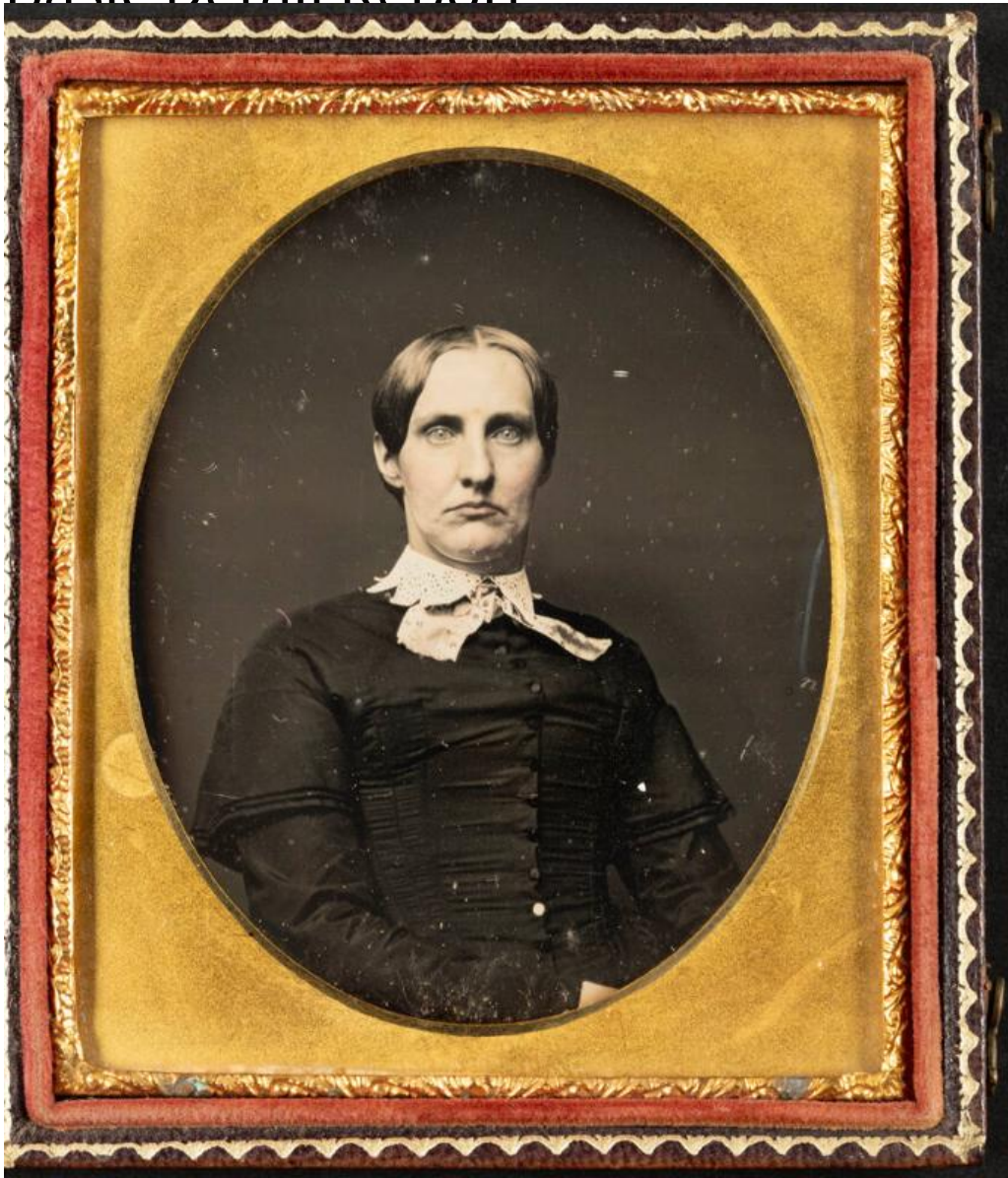


# Basic Detail Report



**Title** Unknown woman, possibly in the Burleigh family

**Date** about 1850

**Primary Maker** Unknown

**Medium** Daguerreotype; silver-coated copper plate in brass window mat package in tooled leather-covered wooden case; embossed red velvet pad in left side of open case

**Description** Sixth-plate daguerreotype of an unknown woman, possibly a member of the Burleigh family, by an unknown photographer. The woman is in

her late thirties or early forties. She is wearing a dark dress with a narrow bodice over a corset. The long sleeves of the dress are capped at the upper arms with shorter sleeves. She is wearing a turned-down lace collar over what appear to be lace ribbons. Her hair is parted in the middle and pulled back, her ears visible.

Dimensions Plate (height x width):  $3 \frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{3}{4}$ in. ( $8.3 \times 7$ cm) Other (case height x width x depth):  $3 \frac{5}{8} \times 3 \frac{1}{8} \times \frac{1}{2}$ in. ( $9.2 \times 7.9 \times 1.3$ cm)
