Title Harriet Jones Crawford

Date about 1855

Medium Daguerreotype; silver-coated copper plate in brass window mat package in tooled leather-covered wooden case. The two halves of the case are separated. Red silk pad in top/left side of case.

Description Sixth-plate daguerreotype of Harriet Jones Crawford by photographer William Shew (or in a case made by Shew; it's unclear). She is

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wearing a knitted jacket over her dress. Her hair is parted in the middle and fashioned into curls that cover her ears.

Dimensions Plate (height x width): $3 \frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{3}{4}$ in. (8.3 × 7cm) Other (case height x width x depth): $3 \frac{5}{8} \times 3 \frac{1}{8} \times \frac{1}{2}$ in. (9.2 × 7.9 × 1.3cm)
