Basic Detail Report

Description Ninth plate tintype of Hattie Dickinson (her full name was probably Harriet). She is young, probably in her late teens or early twenties. She is wearing a dress with a tight bodice, wide, belled sleeves, and a full skirt. A lace collar is fastened with a brooch. Her hair is parted in the middle, pulled back, and adorned with ribbons.

Dimensions Plate (image plate height x width): $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2$ in. (6.4×5.1 cm) Other (case height x width x depth): $3 \times 2\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{2}$ in. ($7.6 \times 6.4 \times 1.3$ cm)
