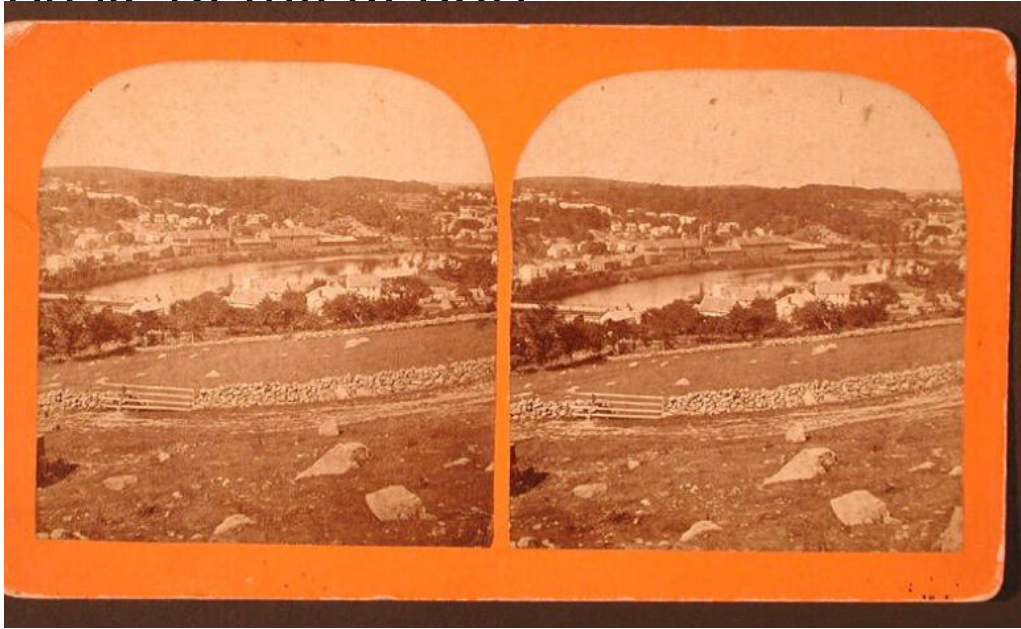

Description Views of Norwich, Connecticut: general and street views, including the County Jail, the City Reservoir, the New London County Fair Grounds, a church possibly identified on verso as the Bean Hill Church, the north front and upper end of the Mill in Baltic after the flood of 26 March 1876; panoramas, including a general view of the Norwich Town valley, and a view from Lanman's Hill.
