**Title** Windham Inn after the Storm, Jan. 3, 1903

**Description** A two and a half story red inn building with two central red brick chimneys and a wrap-around porch. A thick layer of snow is on the ground.

Leafless snow-covered trees surround the inn. Other buildings, one of them a shed, are on the left and right.
