Description Bird's-eye view of the Cheney Brothers factories in South Manchester, Connecticut. There are three large, multi-story factory buildings in the foreground. They all have flat roofs. The middleground is filled with trees and a few houses scattered between them. There are hills or low mountains in the distance.
