Topics discussed include Jeremiah's childhood in Trinidad and Tobago; coming to the United States for farm labor; impressions of America and racial discrimination; work in Ohio, New Jersey, and Connecticut; getting married; personalities at the West Indian Social Club in the 1950s; working as the Chair of Health and Welfare at the Social Club;

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working at Gold Bond Mattresses in Hartford; his children; and accepting

Jamaican dominance in the Social Club and supporting both the West Indian
