Medium Daguerreotype; silver-coated copper plate behind brass window mat and glass plate in tooled leather-covered wooden case. Purple silk pad in left side of open case with brown thread stitched into it.

Basic Detail Report

Description Sixth plate daguerreotype of one-year-old Luthera Maria Bromley, who is wearing a long white dress and sitting on a patterned carpet. Probably taken to mark the occasion of her first birthday. She died shortly thereafter. The stitches on the purple silk pad possibly held a lock of the child's hair.

Dimensions Plate (image plate height x width): $3 \frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{3}{4}$ in. (8.3×7 cm)

Other (case height x width x depth): $3 \frac{3}{4} \times 3 \frac{1}{4} \times \frac{1}{2}$ in. ($9.5 \times 8.3 \times 1.3$ cm)
