specifications PQD 96C. The shirt features 15 plastic buttons: 7 x front closure, 2 x 2 cuffs, 1 x 2 pockets, 2 x rear collar for protective hood attachment. There are special gas protection features in the form of a flap behind the front closure, gusset-like pieces of material behind the cuff openings, and two buttons behind the collar for attaching a hood. There is an Air Corps patch on the proper left shoulder, and a patch on the proper right wrist, the patch is circular and features gold embroidery on a navy backing.
