Title Woman's Overshoes

Date about 1840-1845

Primary Maker Unknown

Medium Molded rubber and cotton

Description Molded rubber shoes with a slit vamp; to either side of the slit are punched two pairs of eyelets for a tie. The toe is square and the sole is flat. The shoe is lined with a heavily napped, twilled, brown cotton, which is seamed down the middle. The rubber is embossed with lines to imitate seaming. The sole is not separate; it is molded one with the upper. The backs of the shoes are punched with holes, threaded with the remnants of brown string.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (length x height x width): $8 \frac{3}{4} \times 2 \frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{3}{4}$ in.
