## Title Woman's Shoes

Date about 1850-1855

Primary Maker Lemuel Horton

Medium Hand-stitched leather and cotton, with silk tape and printed paper label

Description Shiny black kid leather slippers, styled with square toe, square throatline, and flat sole. The upper is lined in the quarters with white kidskin and in the vamp in white twill-woven cotton. The throatline is bound with black silk /cotton tape. The slippers are plain, without adornment. The soles are straight.
