Description Map of Eastford, Connecticut, from North Ashford to the north, Fire Tower Road to the east, Hall's Pond to the south, and Axe Factory Road to the west. Numbers presumably corresponding to land lots are marked on the map, and natural features such as rivers, ponds and brooks are labeled. Names include Bungay Brook, Indian Hut Brook, and Slovik Brook.
