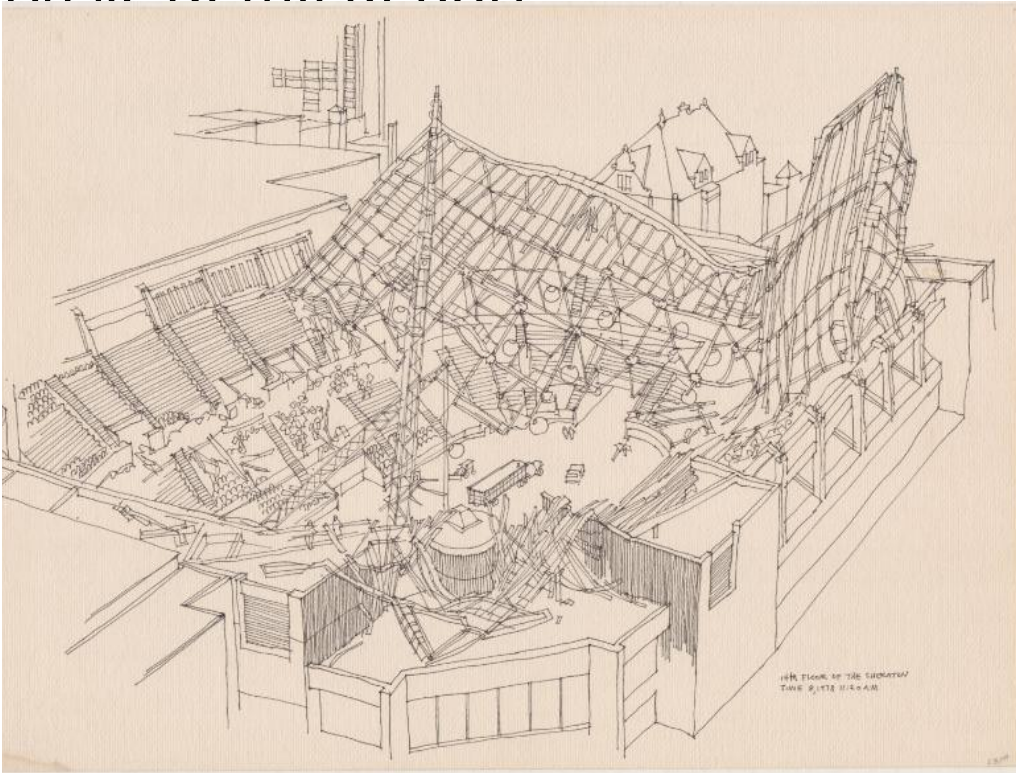

Description Drawing of the debris removal process following the collapse of the Civic Center's roof in Hartford, Connecticut, from an elevated perspective.
