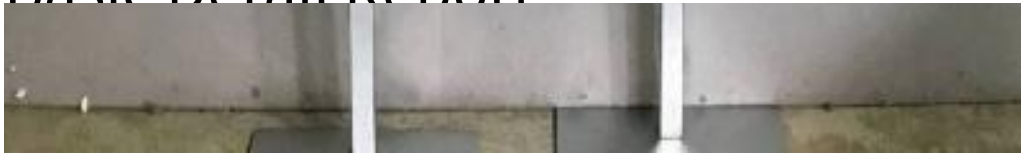

Description U. S. Navy WAVES (Women Accepted for Volunteer Emergency

Service) summer uniform worn by Elizabeth Nolan. The uniform comprises a (a)

service jacket and (b) skirt. (a) The uniform jacket is a cream colored lightweight,

single breasted, notch lapel blazer with long sleeves, shoulder pads, and a four

shell button front closure. No exterior decoration, the interior of the jacket

features breast pockets on both the proper left and proper right sides of the

bodice. The proper right breast pocket has a patch featuring an anchor and

reads, "Made and sold under the authority of U.S. Navy. U. S. Women' s Naval

Reserve" . There is a label tacked at the interior proper right side seam that

reads, "135." (b) The uniform skirt is a cream colored lightweight, A-line, calf

length skirt with two front pockets and both a metal zipper and molded plastic

button closure on the proper right side. No exterior decoration, the interior of

the skirt features a Navy WAVES tag at the interior center back.

(64.8 × 36.8cm) Skirt ((b) skirt center front x waist): 27 1/4 × 25in. (69.2 × 63.5

cm)
