Medium Melton wool, cotton-twill, plastic

Description U. S. Army enlisted man' s overcoat, double-breasted, ulster-style design with notched lapel and roll collar in olive drab 32-ounce melton wool with a partial lining of 8.2-ounce cotton-twill. The overcoat has 9, 1inch diameter light brown plastic great seal buttons, 7 on the front for closure and two on the back belt, 2 half-inch light brown plastic great seal buttons on shoulders, and nine basic half-inch diameter buttons in brown plastic. Identifying information has been stamped on the lining of the upper back in black, "A 3849" , "40R" .
Worn by Mitchell Arron during the Korean War.
