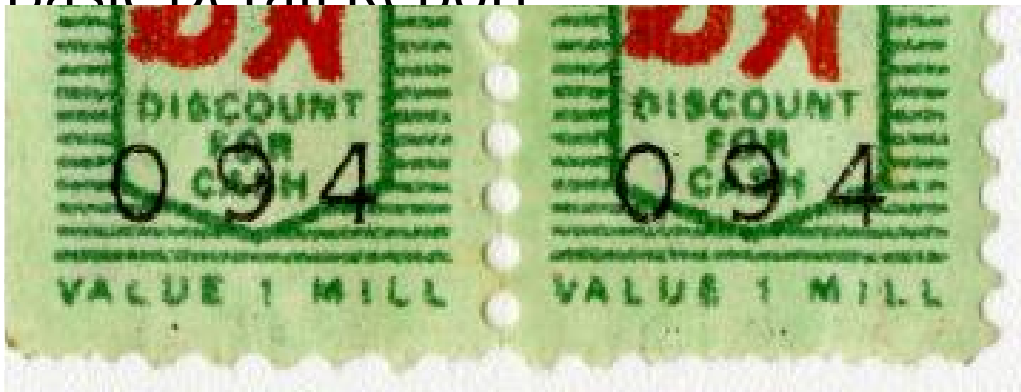

Description Set of six S&H Green Stamps, perforated paper rectangle with gummed reverse. The upper left corner of the sheet is torn off. S&H Green Stamps was a line of trading stamps popular in the United States from 1896 until the late 1980s. They were distributed as part of a rewards program operated by the Sperry & Hutchinson company (S&H), founded in 1896 by Thomas Sperry and Shelley Byron Hutchinson.
