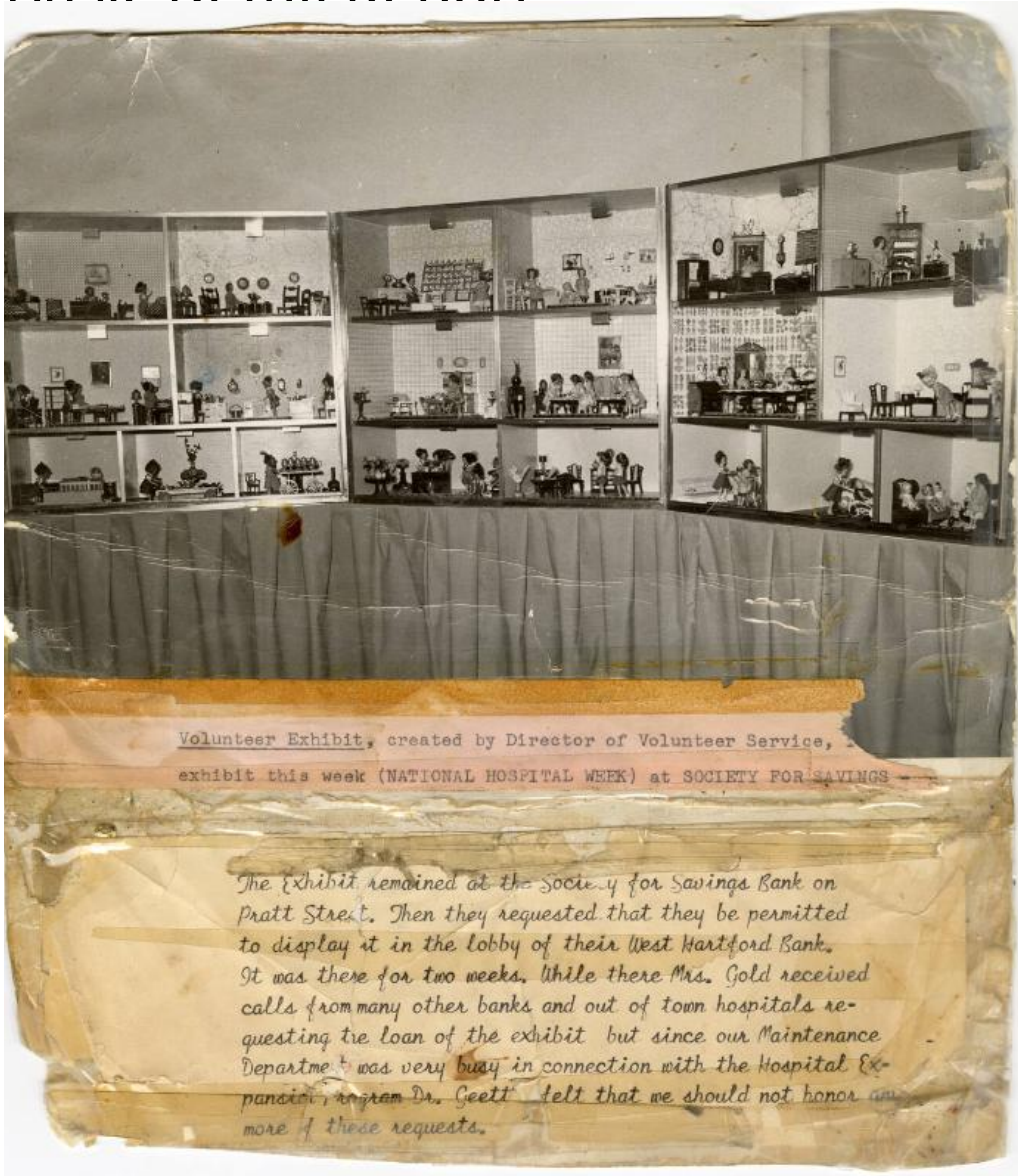


Basic Detail Report

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display at the Society for Savings Bank on Pratt Street in Hartford, then was

displayed at the Society for Savings Bank's West Hartford location for two
