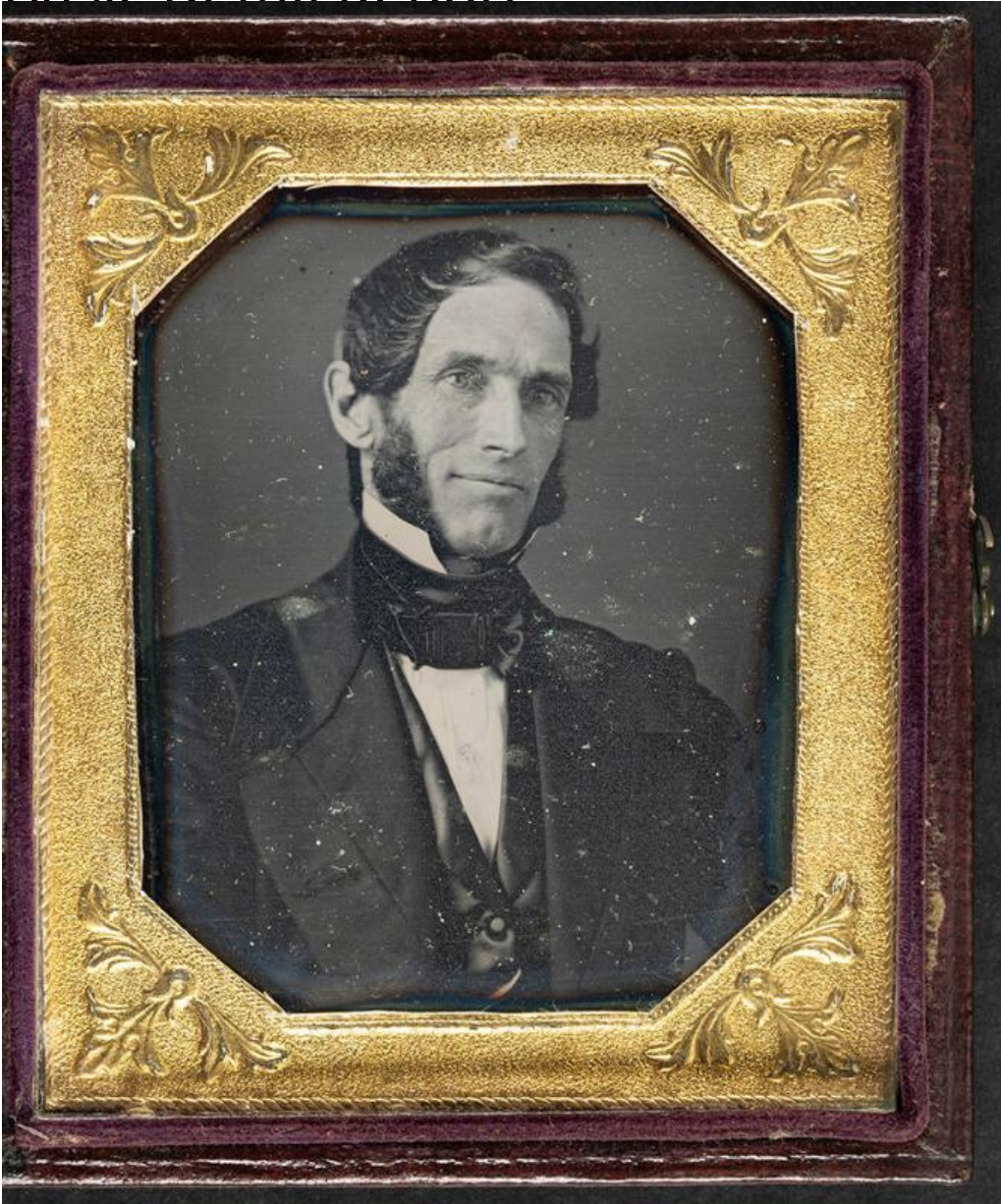

Basic Detail Report

Description Sixth-plate daguerreotype portrait of Seth W. Craige, Jr. by an

unknown photographer. Craige is wearing a dark jacket, a dark vest (probably silk or satin, judging by the sheen), a white shirt with a high, starched collar, and a cravat. His hair is oiled and combed forward onto his forehead, which suggests that he had been wearing a hat that the photographer asked him to remove. He had quite long and bushy sideburns, but is otherwise clean-shaven.

Dimensions Plate (height x width): $3 \frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{3}{4}$ in. (8.3×7 cm) Other (case

height x width x depth): $3 \frac{5}{8} \times 3 \frac{1}{8} \times \frac{5}{8}$ in. ($9.2 \times 7.9 \times 1.6$ cm)
