

THE FRENCH REVOLUTION.
SCENE OF THE DESTRUCTION AT THE PALACE ROYAL.

The furniture was hurled from the windows into the court-yard and hurled together with the debris in which Louis Philippe first met as King of the French.

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Description Soldiers in uniform stand in ranks in the courtyard of a large stone palace, while crowds of people in the interior of the building throw furniture from the windows. Chairs, tables, cushions, a pitcher, a bottle, a book, and several paintings in gilt frames fly through the air. Some men lie on the ground, dead or wounded. Two soldiers carry an injured comrade. Some soldiers are on horseback. In the background, some men in civilian clothes are entering the palace through an arched doorway.
