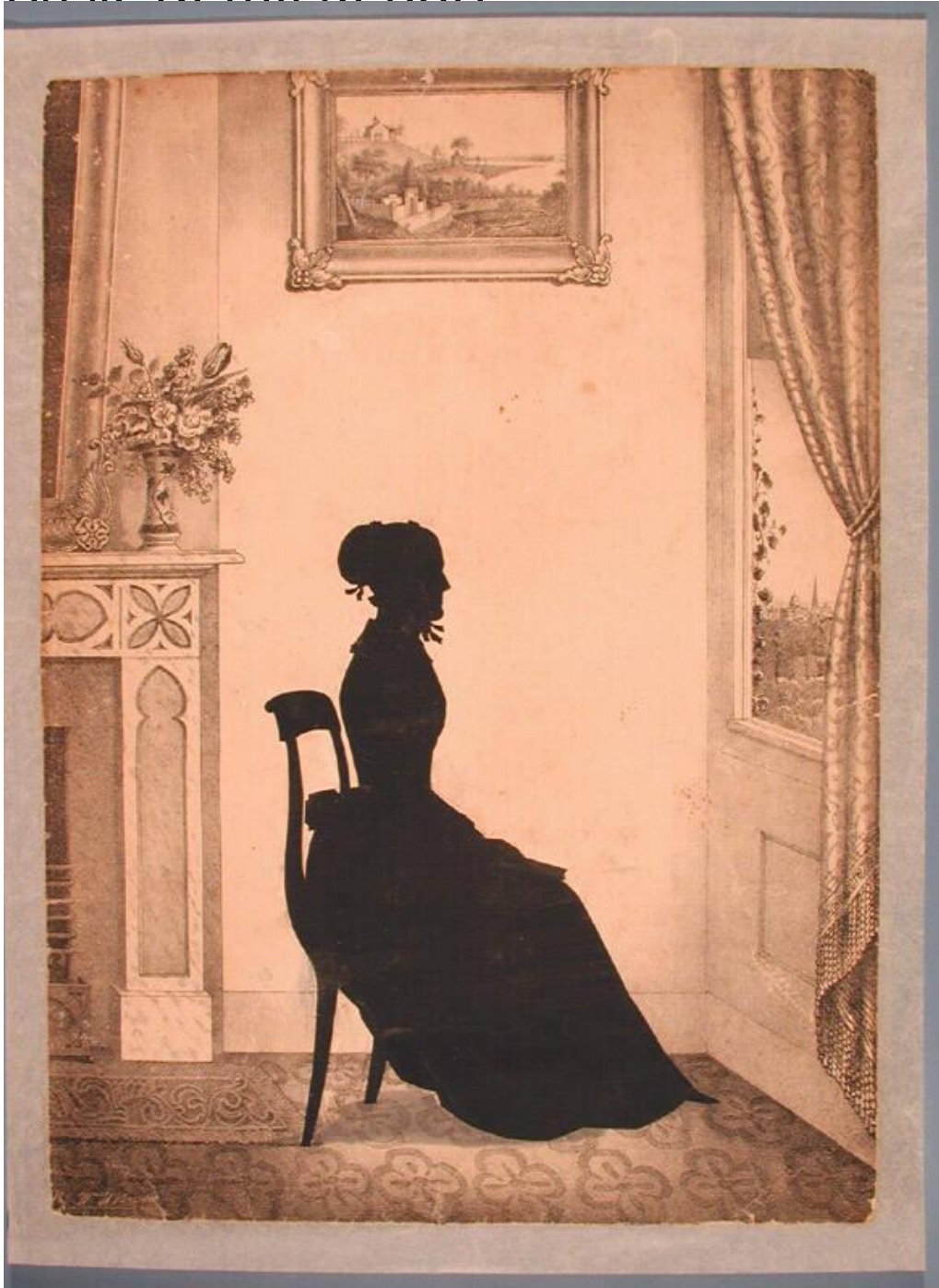

A landscape painting in a gilt frame hangs on the wall in the center. Trees, a church steeple, and a domed building, probably the Pearl Street Church and the Old State House in Hartford, are visible through the open window at the right. Vines grow on the window frame.
