His left arm is around the waist of the girl on the right, who leans her chin on her hand and her elbow on the boy's left knee. She wears a short-sleeved dress with a gathered bodice and holds a straw bonnet by its ribbon ties. The girl on the left wears a dress and a straw bonnet. A fringed blanket or shawl lies across her lap. Both her hands rest on the boy's right shoulder. A small drawstring bag or reticule lies on the ground. Two tall trees are at the left beside a wide stream or river. Two horses (or two teams of horses) draw a wagonload of hay across a wooden bridge in the left background. A house with a picket fence is in the right background. A dead tree is on the far right, with a rail fence nearby. Grassy fields slope down towards the river. Additional trees are in the background; hills or mountains are in the distance. Birds fly in the sky at the left.
