Title Figured Flask

Date about 1850-1870

Primary Maker Westford Glass Company

Medium Mold-blown aquamarine glass

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Description Figured flask made of mold-blown aquamarine glass. The flask has a plain, broken rim, a cylindrical neck, rounded shoulders and tapered sides, a flattened body, and a shallow kick on the bottom. One side of the flask has the raised, arched word "TRAVELER's" over the reverse-arched word "COMPANION". The other side of the flask has a raised, eight-pointed star. The rim or collar has completely broken away from the flask.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x width x depth): $5 \frac{7}{8} \times 3 \frac{1}{4} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ in.
