people. Many of those photographs are formal studio portraits of men, women,

and children. Some photographs show men in uniform including a soldier, a

police officer, a hockey player, and trolley conductors. Some are wedding

photographs while other formal studio photographshow men and women

holding books or walking canes. The women wear dresses with beading, pins on

the collars, and hats with flowers. Photographs of children show small girls and

infants. The first two photographs are of Chauncy Olcott, a famous tenor singer.
