Forest Street in South Manchester, Connecticut. The image is taken from the

dining room, looking into the library through a doorway. Both rooms have wood

floors, covered by decorative rugs. In the foreground, to the left, part of a dining

chair is visible. Behind it is a buffet table, sitting against the wall of the dining

room to the left of the doorway into the library. There are candles on top of the

buffet, and a framed picture hanging on the wall behind them. The dining room

walls are covered in a floral scrollwork wallpaper. A large desk or table is visible

through the doorway, in the middle of the library. There is a lamp sitting on it

and several chairs arranged around it. The back wall of the library is lined with

short bookshelves that are filled with books. There are a few decorative pieces
