Standing in the back row, left to right are: Walter Bowden Cheney (1864-1913), Robert Cheney (1859-1935), Harriet Bowen Cheney (1867-1938), Louis Richmond Cheney (1859-1944), Bess Cheney (probably Elizabeth Cheney (1865-1898)), William Coates Cheney (1864-1941), Helen Cheney (1868-1937), Wells Wadsworth Cheney (1857-1938), Emily "Milly" Cheney wearing a Worth gown, Edward "Ned" Moyle Cheney (1862-1888) and Herman Cheney (probably Charles Herman

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Cheney (1866-1961)). Seated in the middle row are: Frank Cheney, Jr. (1860-1957), Maude Cheney (probably Alice Maude Cheney (1862-1942)), May Cheney (probably Mary "May" Bissell Cheney (1866-1890)), Alice Barrett Cheney (1858-1908), Harry Grant Cheney (1852-1918), Mary "Polly" Cheney (1855-1934), George Herbert Cheney (1861-1929) and Florence Cheney (probably Florence Douglas Cheney (1864-1916)).
