(1868-1931) as an adult. He is looking off camera to the left. Henry is wearing a

white collared shirt with a string bow tie under a vest and jacket. He is wearing

pince-nez spectacles and a pocket watch. Henry's hair is parted sharply down

the middle and slicked down at the sides. Photograph is mounted on a piece of

cardstock that has beveled edges.
