Description Sixth-plate daguerreotype of Abigail Hurlburt Case by an unknown photographer. She is wearing a dark dress with vertical pleats on the bodice, a

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white lace collar, and small lace cuffs at the sleeves. She is holding in her hand a

daguerreotype case.

Dimensions Plate (height x width): $3 \frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{3}{4}$ in. (8.3×7 cm) Other (case

height x width x depth): $3 \frac{1}{2} \times 3 \frac{1}{8} \times \frac{1}{2}$ in. ($8.9 \times 7.9 \times 1.3$ cm)
